Why is reading with your child important?

Reading aloud...

- Stimulates your child's imagination
- Creates a bond between you and your child
- Builds vocabulary
- Improves your child's listening skills
- Develops your child's interest in reading & books

Helpful Hints:

-If your child asks for a story to be read again, Read It Again! Repetition is good!

-Choose stories that both of you will enjoy!

*Parents looking for the next book to enjoy? The Read-Aloud Family by Sarah Mackenzie is a great read!

REMINDERS:

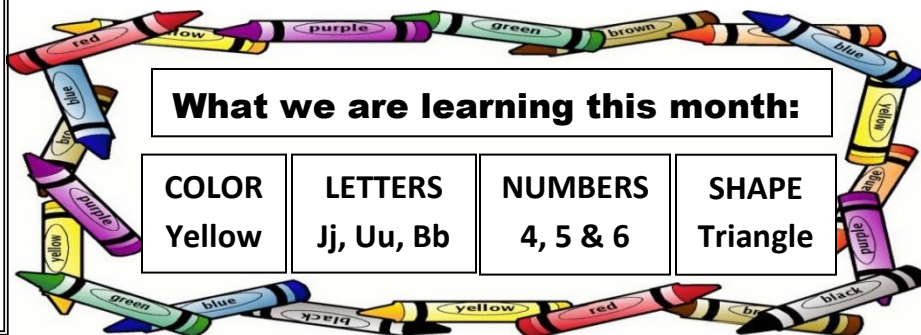

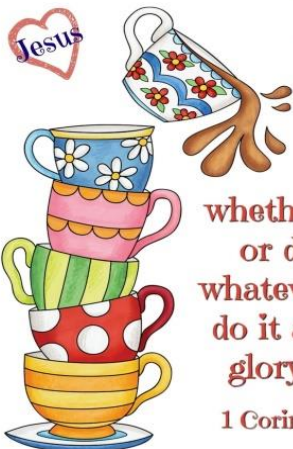
